

## **Weed Control:**

A weed is defined as a plant growing where it is not wanted. Weeds are unsightly, compete with turfgrass for light, soil nutrients, soil moisture and space. Dandelions can produce up to 12,000 seeds per plant. Some weed seeds can even survive in the soil for 40 years. Weeds are a host for all types of pests including pathogens, nematodes, and insects. Some people can have allergic reactions to certain types of weeds.
